

Linda Di Carlo, pianist and harpsichord player, is a professor of Music Conservatory "F. Morlacchi" in Perugia but has also an intense concert activity that leads her to perform for important festivals and concert societies in Italy and abroad (Brazil, Spain, Tunisia, Turkey, Kosovo, Czech Republic, Germany, Switzerland, Japan).

With Quintetto Bottesini she successfully toured Poland, Jordan, Ecuador, USA, Brazil, Venezuela, Turkey, The Netherlands and France and played for "I Concerti del Quirinale di RadioTre ", live on national italian radio.

Her particular inclination for chamber music led her to perform with internationally renowned musicians such as Richard Stoltzman, Alessandro Carbonare, Corrado Giuffredi, the Winds of s. Cecilia, Danilo Rossi, Paolo Beltramini, the Quartetto Savinio, the Quartetto di Cremona, the Bernini Quartet, Quartetto Fonè and singers Daniela Bruera, Marina Comparato, Laura Brioli.

She has made recordings for the Sagra Musicale Umbra, the Camerata Tokyo label, and cds with Quintetto Bottesini for "Amadeus" music magazine and Brilliant Classics.

She's also harpsichord player and founder member of the Orchestra da Camera di Perugia.
